OUR IMPACT



Last year, we:

- Reached 2,412 students and provided 282 in-school workshops and 27 field trips to teach students about local food systems and healthy eating choices through our Farm-to-School program
- Distributed \$542,938 worth of local food (a 15% increase from last year) from 51 farms and producers to 116 schools, retailers, restaurants, food shelves, and other institutions through our food hub, Green Mountain Farm Direct
- Helped our region's children have enough to eat during the summer months, by providing nearly 4,000 free nutritious meals through our Lunchbox program
- Gave 50 coolers of free garden produce, local milk, and eggs to community members in need in the Northeast Kingdom during the summer months
- Delivered 130 free meals per week directly to 65 migrant farmworkers located at 10 different farms in Orleans County through the Everyone Eats initiative
